Dress Code Standards for Imagine Rosefield

Our uniform policy acts as a unifying feature that helps students avoid distractions from our larger mission. Uniforms are also a visible representation to our community representing our pride and professionalism in Imagine Rosefield. Students are expected to follow uniform guidelines. In instances where students are out of compliance, parents will be notified and expected to bring appropriate uniform clothing to the school. *The school administration will have final say on all dress code issues*.

Guidelines	>	Polo shirts (long/short sleeved) with Imagine Schools logo <i>Light Blue, Navy Blue, Red or White</i>
for all	>	Uniform shirts must be always tucked in.
Students		Undershirts (long or short sleeve) must be <i>Light Blue, Navy Blue, Red or White</i>
		Uniform bottoms must be <i>Navy or Khaki</i>
		Sweatshirts, hoodies, zip up hoodies, or cardigan sweaters in solid color with or without
		school logo (Imagine Prep logo acceptable) may be worn anywhere in the building Light
		Blue, Navy Blue, White, Red, Gray or Black. No other writing or logo permitted!
Outerwear	>	No coats, jackets, or non-uniform sweatshirts, hoodies, or cardigans inside the school.
		Students must carry them in the hallway and hang them up in the classroom.
Footwear	>	Closed toed shoes, which cover both the toes and heels. Boots and shoes must be mid-calf
		or below with less than a one-inch heel (safety). No flip-flops, slippers, slipper boots, Crocs ,
		jelly shoes, or Uggs. Socks must be below the knee and match if visible.
	>	Blue jeans (only) worn secured at the natural waist with a school logo spirit t-shirt or
Friday		uniform polo shirt. No ripped jeans allowed. Shirts may be untucked on Fridays only.

		Leggings/tights of approved school colors can be worn under school appropriate bottoms.
		Leggings/tights must be solid colors: black, gray, navy blue, light blue, or white.

Guidelines		Shorts or pants worn secured at the natural waist <i>Navy or Khaki</i> . Shorts no shorter than
for Boys		three (3) inches above the knee or longer than one (1) inch below the knee
Unacceptable		Light up & shoes with wheels are not permitted at any time.
Items		No flip-flops, slippers, slipper boots, Crocs, jelly shoes, or Uggs.
		Torn, tethered, or ripped clothing , oversized shirts.
	>	Baseball caps, hats, bandanas while inside the building (permitted for outside activities)
		Body art/tattoos (permanent or temporary)
		Bulky jewelry or chains, bracelets, rings, chokers, etc.
	>	Piercings (except for one pair of non-dangling earrings in the ears)
	>	Untied sneakers or shoes falling off and not secured
